The museum is just east of US 301 near the MD/DE border. The Massey Airport (MD1), is a well maintained 3000 turf runway with good approaches. The meeting will be hosted by UFO Delaware Area Representative John Chirtea and the Massey Air Museum.

No event or task is risk free. But, as pilots, we are accustomed to managing risk. We will conform with all local policies and good practices. We discourage anyone from attending who has been involved in virus "risky behavior", recently been exposed to folks who have had the virus, are showing relevant medical symptoms, etc. You cannot get the virus unless someone brings it to the event. Testing shortly before you attend would be a plus.

Most of the folks in our age group are well behaved and prudent. We will minimize contact with non-UFO members. Masks are optional. Elbow bumps are encouraged. Hand sanitizer and masks for those who neglected to bring one will be available.


You are encouraged to review the Massy Museum website at www.masseyaero.org. There are many other interesting links once you get to the Massey Air Museum web site.

Arrival by car:

Enter 33541 Maryland Line Rd., Massey, MD into your GPS.

The Airport/Museum are just east of US 301 near the DE/MD border.



Arrival by Air:

Massey (MD1) is an exceptionally well-kept airport with a wide 3000-foot long turf runway. Suggest you look at www.airnav.com/airport/MD1 for detailed info.

The airport is outside the DC SFRA. However, there are other complications. When President Biden is at home in Wilmington, DE there may be a Presidential TFR very close to MD1. Pay attention to the NOTAMS. Typically, the Presidential TFR is only active on weekends. Suggest you talk to Dover Approach Control on 132.425 approaching MD1.

Massey does not have AWOS. However, EVY AWOS is available on 132.325 (14 NM North). The CTAF at MD1 is 122.9.

UFO folks will be available on 122.9 for help parking and airport transportation as needed.
